New ways of communicating from September

Please make sure you download the app for our new website over the holidays. From September we will no longer be sending text message reminders but will use this app to communicate with you. You will receive a notification when a new message has been sent out. To download the free app you need to search for the Schudio app (not the Schudio Schools app) on your device. Once it is installed it will ask for your location and then give you a choice of schools. Click on Chisenhale. Our upcoming events and term dates are now listed on the calendar. On the app it is on the left-hand side and you need to click on the circled dates to see events on that day. New messages and reminders will be under the messages tab. We are also going to stop sending home paper copies of Chisenhale Chatter as most parents have told us they read the emailed copy and we do not want to waste paper. For those who do prefer a printed newsletter, copies will be available from the office. Please let us know as soon as possible if you do not receive an emailed copy of the newsletter or have any trouble finding your way around the app.
