Dear Parents/Carers,

If we were to receive instruction to close the school, we have prepared a list of home learning for each year group. **Please make sure that your child has an additional bag with their name on in school (this can be a robust carrier bag)** so that we can start to put things in, and send this home once a decision has been made by Government.

We plan to send home:

- An exercise book for children to record their learning.
- At least one reading book to enjoy and reflect on. Please make sure this is returned when we come back to school.
- A paper copy of the home learning ideas linked to the year group curriculum. This will include daily reading, developmental maths recall such as times tables, and provide ideas of other projects linked to our current topics. The children should be able to complete these tasks independently but if you would like to support them, then of course you can.
- Log in details for Times Tables Rockstars for Years 3 – 6.
- Log in details for Studyladder for Years 1 - 6. This is an online platform where the teachers can set children appropriate learning linked to the year group's current curriculum. The children will be shown this website this week and a separate letter with their individual log in details will be send home. Teachers will be able to monitor how children are doing with the tasks and set further tasks for children to complete.
